



Free File: Do your Federal Taxes for Free



Free File is Now Closed

Check back January 2022 to prepare and file your Federal taxes for free.

IRS Free File lets you prepare and file your federal income tax online for free. File at an IRS [partner site](#) with the IRS Free File Program or use Free File Fillable Forms. It's safe, easy and no cost to you for a **federal** return.

To receive a free federal tax return, you must select an IRS Free File provider from the [Browse All Offers](#) page or your Online Lookup Tool results. Once you click your desired IRS Free File provider, you will leave the IRS.gov website and land on the IRS Free File provider's website. Then, you must create an account at the IRS Free File provider's website accessed via Irs.gov to prepare and file your return. Please note that an account created at the same provider's commercial tax preparation website does NOT work with IRS Free File: you MUST access the provider's Free File site as instructed above.

Pick an option based on your income

Income \$72,000 and below:

- Free federal tax filing on an IRS partner site
- State tax filing (free with **some** offers)
- Guided preparation – simply answer questions
- Online service does all the math

Income above \$72,000:

- Free electronic forms you fill out and file yourself
- No state tax filing
- You should know how to prepare paper forms
- Basic calculations with limited guidance

What Is IRS Free File?

The IRS Free File Program is a public-private partnership between the IRS and many tax preparation and filing software industry leaders who provide their brand-name products for free. It provides two ways for taxpayers to prepare and file their federal income tax online for free:

- Traditional IRS Free File provides free online tax preparation and filing options on IRS partner sites. Our partners are online tax preparation companies that develop and deliver this service at no cost to qualifying

taxpayers. Please note, only taxpayers whose [adjusted gross income \(or AGI\)](#) is \$72,000 or less qualify for any IRS Free File partner offers.

- Free File Fillable Forms are electronic federal tax forms you can fill out and file online for free. If you choose this option, you should know how to prepare your own tax return. Please note, it is the only IRS Free File option available for taxpayers whose [income \(AGI\)](#) is greater than \$72,000.

Choose an IRS Free File [option](#) from a partner company, prepare and file your federal tax return on their site, and get an email when we accept your return.

IRS Free File Program offers the [most commonly filed forms and schedules](#) for taxpayers.

⊖ About IRS Free File Partnership with Online Tax Preparation Companies

The IRS Free File program is a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) between the IRS and the Free File Alliance, a coalition of leading tax preparation software companies. IRS Free File partners are online tax preparation companies that offer what is called the “IRS Free File” program, which provides free electronic tax preparation and filing of federal tax returns at no cost to qualifying taxpayers (some may also offer free state returns). The IRS Free File program PPP is not a traditional contractual arrangement; this partnership represents a balance of joint responsibility and collaboration that serves the interests of taxpayers and the Federal government. The online tax preparation software partners are part of the [Free File Alliance](#), which coordinates with the IRS to provide free electronic federal tax preparation and filing to you. This non-profit, public-private partnership is dedicated to helping millions of people prepare and file their federal taxes online for free.

⊖ What You Need to Get Started

Personal Information You Need

- A copy of last year's tax return in order to access your [Adjusted Gross Income \(AGI\)](#)
- Valid Social Security numbers for yourself, your spouse, and any dependent, if applicable

Income and Receipts

- Social Security benefits
- Unemployment Compensation
- All receipts pertaining to your small business, if applicable
- Income receipts from rental, real estate, royalties, partnerships, S corporation, trusts

Other income

- [W-2s](#), showing your annual wages from all of your employers
- [Form 1099-INT](#), showing interest paid to you throughout the year
- [Form 1099-G](#), showing any refund, credit or offset of state and local taxes
- [Forms 1099-DIV](#) and [1099-R](#), showing dividends and distributions from retirement and other plans paid to you during the year

ACA Filers

File Electronically

- When self-preparing your taxes and filing electronically, you must [sign and validate your electronic tax return](#). To verify your identity, use last year's AGI or last year's self-select signature personal identification number (PIN). To sign your electronic tax return, use a 5 digit self-select PIN, any five numbers (except all zeros) that you choose that will which serves as your electronic signature.
- If you do not know last year's AGI, have a copy of your prior year tax return, you may use the [IRS Get Transcript self-help tools](#) to get a tax return transcript showing your prior year [AGI](#). You have two options:
 1. Online: obtain the prior year AGI using [IRS Get Transcript self-help tools](#) to get a tax return transcript showing your prior year [AGI](#). Use only the "Adjusted Gross Income" line entry. [Secure Access: How to Register for Certain Online Self-Help Tools](#) provides you with the information you need to make the request.
 2. By Mail: Mail your tax return, allowing 5 to 10 days for delivery. Use only the "Adjusted Gross Income" line entry.

Contact Information

- To get a notification from the Free File software company that your return was accepted by IRS, you need a valid email address.

Information Safety

Your information is protected from any unauthorized access while it is sent to the IRS. Free File partner companies may not disclose or use tax return information for purposes other than tax return preparation without your informed and voluntary consent. These companies are also subject to the Federal Trade Commission Privacy and Safeguards Rules and IRS e-file regulations.

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Prior-Year Returns

Please note you can only file your current year tax return using IRS Free File. You cannot process a prior year return using IRS Free File.

Prior year returns can only be filed electronically by [registered tax preparers](#) for the two previous tax years. The IRS does not allow electronic filing for prior year returns through self-preparation websites. You must print, sign, and mail prior year returns. Our [Directory of Federal Tax Return Preparers with Credentials and Select Qualifications](#) can help you find preparers in your area who currently hold professional credentials recognized by the IRS, or who hold an Annual Filing Season Program Record of Completion. You can also check the [professional organizations](#) many tax preparers belong to.

- Always remember to print your return after you successfully file online. If you forget to print your return, you can order a [free transcript](#). Depending on the type of transcript you request, you'll get more or less of the information from your return.

- Don't have a bank account? To find a bank with an online account that's right for you, check the [FDIC website](#). If you're a veteran, find options with the [Veterans Benefits Banking Program \(VBBP\)](#). You can also ask your tax preparer for electronic payment options.

➔ The Benefits of the Free File Program to You:

- **You can obtain a free federal tax return:** If you are new to Free File, you can choose a Free File company's Free File offer based on your review of the offer qualifications listed on IRS.gov. If you choose a program and qualify, you will not be charged for preparation and e-filing of a federal tax return.
- If you used IRS Free File last year, you will receive an email from the same company that you used, welcoming you back to their official IRS Free File services. The email must include a link to the company's IRS Free File site and explain how to file with it. If you choose this email link and qualify, you will not be charged for preparation and e-filing of a federal tax return.
- **Fees to file your federal return are prohibited:** No participant in the Free File Program will charge you anything to file your federal tax return if you qualify. You will not be asked to buy any products or services (for example, promotional rebates) in exchange for having your Federal tax return prepared by the Free File program participant.
- **Bank products with fees are not a part of Free File.** As part of IRS Free File, you must not be offered bank products that often carry product fees, such as refund transfer products (e.g. refund

anticipation loans (RALs)).

- **Free state returns may be available:** Some IRS Free File Program partner companies offer free state tax preparation. Others charge a state fee. Be sure to read each company's information carefully.
- **Each Free File Company Guarantees the Accuracy of the Return Calculations:** Each company lists this guarantee on its Free File website. You can pursue any accuracy concerns directly with the company that prepared your return.
- **You have choices:** If you don't qualify for an IRS Free File offer after visiting a company's Free File website, you can return to the IRS.gov Free File website to seek a Free File offer that may meet your needs. Each IRS Free File company will provide you information when you don't qualify, with a link back to the IRS.gov Free File site.
- **Seek help if you need it:** If you need help when you are at a company's IRS Free File site and doing your taxes, you may refer to the company's free customer service options.
- **IRS can help find a free option for you.** IRS Free File has an IRS Free File online look-up tool to help you find an offer that best meets your needs.

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
